### What is the CHA?

The Community Health Assessment is a data collection tool used to evaluate the health of a population. Data is shared with the public and used to complete the Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP).

### Why are we doing this?

The Community Health Assessment is mandated by the Public Health Accreditation Board (PHAB) and used to drive community improvement initiatives. This is our opportunity to use the community's voice to drive improvements.

### Our Goals

For the last CHA, we received 2,000 responses. Our goal is to significantly increase our number of responses to accurately reflect the population of Detroit. To do this our distribution efforts must increase as well. Collaboration is key for this to be a successful survey.

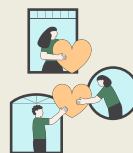
