DETROIT PRIVATIZES TRASH COLLECTION

The City of Detroit has privatized waste removal. The \$122.6 million annual five year contract with Rizzo Environmental Services and Advanced Disposal Services does not save the city any money, but it is an integral part of emergency manager Kevyn Orr's plans to improve city services. The contracts call for weekly trash pickup, bi-weekly bulk trash pickup, bi-weekly curbside recycling, and bi-weekly seasonal yard waste collection.

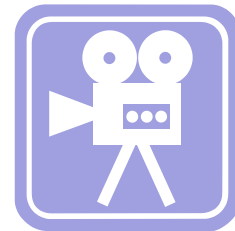
