(WAVE) Fund provides
assistance to low-
income families
during a
crisis by ensuring
uninterrupted access
to safe drinking water
and sanitation services.
Since established,
WAVE has assisted



over **9,100 families**
and
households and has
distributed over **\$2**
million toward
water bills in the
area to help retain
services. Funds are
earmarked
specifically for
payment of water
and sewer bills.
Contributions are
tax deductible and
no water and sewer

revenues are used. The
maximum allowance for
assistance is **50%** of the bill
up to **\$500**. The WAVE
Fund assistance must
restore service or assure
service continuation for at
least 30 days. Customers
may receive WAVE Fund
help **only once** in any
calendar year.. To find out
