Election Day UPDATE - Summer 2014

My fellow residents of Detroit, on Tuesday, August 5, 2014 a State Primary will be held to nominate candidates for Federal, State and Local offices. Precinct Delegates to the County Convention will also be on the ballot, along with the proposals.

Precinct Delegates assist their political parties in "grass roots" voter education, registration and Election Day mobilization in their elected precincts. They also serve as liaisons between the political party, government and their constituents.

The "Election Connection" newsletter has been mailed to each registered voter household in Detroit to provide you with information concerning the Primary. Before going to the polls on Election Day, use the sample ballot to select the candidates you wish to vote for. Take your sample ballot with your predetermined candidates to the voting booth and transfer your choices to the actual ballot that will be issued to you at your polling precinct.

This is a very important Primary for our city and state. We must make democracy work

for us by learning about those you wish to vote for. To ensure that you are choosing the right candidates to represent you, it is important to research them using the local newspapers, other forms of media and online sources. Also attend and actively participate in as many candidate forums as possible. You may even invite candidates to your block club and community meetings. Remember, knowledge is power.

Those who qualify may vote by absentee ballot at the Department of Elections through August 4th. Office hours are Monday - Saturday 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. On Monday, August 4th, you may vote by absentee in the office until 4:00 p.m. If you wish to have an absentee ballot mailed to you, please contact the Absentee Voting Unit at (313) 876-0212. Satellites at Wayne County Community College District's Eastern and Northwest campuses will be open for absentee voting Monday through Friday beginning Monday, July 21st through Monday, August 4th, 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.

Remember:

- Refer to the political composition chart on the back page to determine your respective districts, voting precinct and Election Day polling location.
- When going to vote, please be prepared to present photo ID. If you do not have photo ID, you must fill out and sign an affidavit.
- Polls open at 7:00 a.m. and close at 8:00 p.m. Anyone in line before the polls close will be allowed to vote.

| COUNTY | COUNTY | WAYNE COUNTY REGIONAL EDUCATIONAL SERVICE AGENCY REGIONAL ENHANCEMENT MILLAGE PROPOSAL Pursuant to state law, the revenue raised by the proposed enhancement millage will be collected by the Wayne County Regional Educational Service Agency and distributed to local public school districts within the boundaries of the Wayne County Regional Educational Service Agency based on pupil membership count. Shall the limitation on the amount of ad valorem taxes which may be imposed on taxable property in the Wayne County Regional Educational Service Agency, Michigan, be increased by 2.00 mills (\$2 per thousand dollars of taxable value) for a period of six (6) years, 2014 to 2019, inclusive, as new additional millage to provide operating funds to enhance other state and local funding for local school district operating purposes? It is estimated that 2 mills would raise approximately \$80,000,000 when first levied in 2014. للاتخاب: قم بتعليم الشكل البيضاوي المقابل لكل اختيار كاملا كالتالي:  **هام:** لتعليم ورقتك الانتخابية استخدم الحبر الأسود أو الأزرق فقط. لا تستخدم أي لون حبر آخر!

القسم الحزبي: للاتخاب في القسم الحزبي، يمكنك انتخاب «اللائحة كاملة» أو «اللائحة منقسمة» أو «اللائحة مختلطة».

«اللائحة كاملة»: انتخب الحزب الذي تختاره. لا حاجة للقيام بأي شيء آخر في القسم الحزبي.

«اللائحة منقسمة»: بإمكانك انتخاب «اللائحة كاملة» بالإضافة الى انتخاب مرشحين أفراد من اختيارك.

«اللائحة مختلطة»: انتخب مرشح من اختيارك لكل منصب على حدة.

القسم غير الحزبي والمقترحات الانتخابية: على ورقة الاقتراع عليك ان تنتخب المرشحين بشكل منفصل.

لا تنتخب عدد من المرشحين يفوق العدد المطلوب حسب المبين لكل منصب.

مرشحون تكتب اسماءهم بنفسك: لانتخاب مرشح اسمه غير مطبوع على ورقة الاقتراع، اكتب أو ضع اسم المرشح في الفراغ المخصص لذلك وقم بتعليم الشكل البيضاوي المقابل له كاملا. هذه الخطوة عليك القيام بها حتى لو انتخب لائحة حزبية كاملة. لا تقم بتدوين اسم المرشح اذا اسمه كان موجودا اصلا تحت المنصب الذي تريد انتخابه له.

قم بالتحقق من جهتي ورقة الاقتراع: ان ورقة الاقتراع هذه لها جهتين. تأكد من أنك تحققت من الجهة المقابلة من ورقة الاقتراع.

عندما تنتهي من عملية الانتخاب: قم بوضع ورقة الاقتراع في «ظرف السرية» حتى تتأكد أن اختياراتك لا يمكن ان يراها أحد. تأكد أن رقم ورقة الاقتراع يبقى ظاهراً عند ادخاله في «ظرف السرية» ثم أعيد ورقة الاقتراع الى المسؤول الانتخابي عن الحاسوب. (إذا كنت تنتخب عبر ورقة اقتراع غيبائية، اتبع التعليمات الصادرة عن الكاتب (كليك) لتسليم ورقة الاقتراع).

ملاحظة: في حال اقترفت خطأ في تعبئة ورقة الاقتراع، يمكنك مراجعة المسؤول الانتخابي للحصول على نسخة جديدة لاستخدامها. لا تحاول أن تمحو أي علامات وضعتها بالخطأ على ورقة الاقتراع.
