

**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2005-2**



**SUBJECT: CONTINUED REDUCTION OF PAY AND HOURS FOR NON-UNION EXECUTIVE BRANCH APPOINTEES AND EMPLOYEES**

**DATE: DECEMBER 22, 2005**

Pursuant to the powers vested in me by the 1963 Michigan Constitution, the 1997 Detroit City Charter, and Section 13-2-18 of the 1984 Detroit City Code, I, Kwame M. Kilpatrick, Mayor of the City of Detroit, hereby issue this executive order. Due to on-going fiscal difficulties occasioned by a shortfall in revenue facing the City of Detroit, it has become necessary to continue the reduction in hours and resulting pay for Executive Branch appointees and nonunion employees that was established by Executive Order No. 2005-1. Therefore, Executive Order No. 2005-1 is extended and, unless extended by further order, shall expire on June 30, 2006.

This executive order is effective this date.
