Mourning

The Citizens of the City of Detroit share in the national sorrow over the passing of the Hon. Richard M. Nixon, former President of the United States. The contributions made by President Nixon, particularly in foreign policy, have done much to make possible the present spirit of cooperation between the United States and former enemy nations of Russia and the Republic of China. Mr. Nixon's long career in public service did not end with the Presidency; in recent months, he has served a valuable role in advising President Clinton on foreign policy matters.

The City of Detroit honors the memory of President Nixon. For this reason, as Mayor of the City of Detroit, I have ordered that all City of Detroit flags be flown at half staff for a period of thirty days, beginning with the date of President Nixon's passing, April 22, 1994.
