
Keep Drains Clear of Fat, Oil & Grease

Avoid Costly Sewer Backups and Protect our Environment



- Dispose of all fat, oil and grease in an appropriate recycling bin.
- Scrape, then dry wipe pots, pans and dishes.
- Properly install grease trap/ interceptor.
- Use a three-sink dishwashing system.
- Regularly clean kitchen exhaust filters
- Cover grease and oil containers kept outside and keep them away from storm drains.
- Keep drains clean by using vinegar and warm water or commercial products to dissolve grease.

- Don't pour fat, oil or grease down the drain.
- Don't put garbage and food scraps down the drain.
- Don't flush your grease trap or interceptor with hot water.
- Don't dump grease down storm drains.
