# **UNFINISHED BUSINESS (CONT.)**

- 2015 Michigan Residential Code-Arc Fault Letter: More research is needed to find out the specific code making panel in which the Board's letter should be addressed.
- Public Act 73 of 2016: A letter will be sent to Governor Snyder in opposition of Public Act 73 of 2016 (formerly House Bill 4813) and copied to Mr. Marty Mulcahy, Managing Editor of The Building Tradesmen Newsletter.
- City of Seattle's Light Rail System: In the March board meeting Mr. McAlister mentioned the City of Seattle in regard to traffic management systems in relation to his Plan Review presentation at the Reciprocal Council. In viewing Seattle's 2014 Electrical Code (Seattle's version of the Part 8 Rules) for research for the presentation, as well as, speaking with one of Seattle's Plan Reviewers at the presentation, Mr. McAlister found in relation to Seattle's traffic management systems, Subsection A referring to traffic management systems that provide signalization for controlling vehicle, pedestrian, and rolling stock. A traffic management system includes traffic illumination systems, traffic signal systems, traffic monitoring systems, the electrical cabinet and the electrical components that are installed on the load side and signalization systems necessary for the light rail system. Seattle's electrical code far exceeds the state of Washington's electrical code especially in regard to light rail systems. In the future, the Board might want to make recommendations to Ordinance 604-H or other ordinances that address electrical installations within the City of Detroit (i.e. the City's upcoming light rail system). Mr. Brown asked Mr. McAlister to send Seattle's electrical code to the members for review, Mr. McAlister stated he would do so.
