## **PURPOSE**

Public hearings are held to obtain citizen input necessary for HUD Consolidated Plan development for the City of Detroit. Hearing participants are given an opportunity to ask questions and present their opinions regarding Consolidated Plan processes and activity types that can be included in the 2018-2019 Annual Action Plan. The hearing will focus on these matters only, not to discuss funding for particular organizations. During the public hearings, the Housing & Revitalization Department staff will describe the contents of past plans and the types of activities that may be undertaken using 2018-2019 Annual Action Plan program funds.

## **BACKGROUND**

The City of Detroit's current Consolidated Plan covers the period from 2015-2019. The City is in the process of preparing its 2018-2019 Annual Action Plan update. The 2018-2019 Annual Action Plan is the fourth year of the 2015-2019 HUD Consolidated Plan. The HUD Consolidated Plan is a five year strategic plan, updated annually, describing the needs, conditions, objectives, priorities, strategies, and action programs related to community development, affordable housing, the homeless, and housing for persons with special needs, including persons living with HIV and AIDS. The plan is required so the City of Detroit will receive grant funds from certain HUD programs. The Annual Action Plan contains the annual funding applications for the following HUD programs:

- Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)
  - HOME Investment Partnership (HOME)
    - Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG)
- Housing Opportunities For Persons With Aids (HOPWA)

The Housing & Revitalization Department will hold two public hearings each fiscal year. Citizens may submit comments by letter (at the address shown above), appointment, telephone at 313-224-6380 or email at 2018ConPlanComments@detroitmi.gov on or before May 15, 2018.
