

PROCEDURES FOR FILING APPEALS

In order to properly appeal an order issued by the DAH to the Wayne County Circuit Court, you must file the proper documentation and pay the applicable filing and other fees. If you are not certain as to the proper fling and appellate procedures, it may be to your advantage to consult an attorney for assistance. <u>The Department of Appeals & Hearings does not provide legal assistance</u>.

To initiate an Appeal, within 28 days of the date of issuance of the Decision and Order, you must do all of the following:

- 1. At the DAH, pay the DAH Appeal Processing Fee of \$25; and
- 2. At the DAH, file and pay Bond on Appeal equal to amount of judgment (form available at DAH); and
- At the DAH, request copy of hearing transcript and pay \$30 deposit toward cost of transcript (written instructions and forms available at DAH); and
- 4. At Wayne County Clerk's Office, file Claim of Appeal (form available at DAH). Claim of Appeal must indicate "Blight Appeal."
