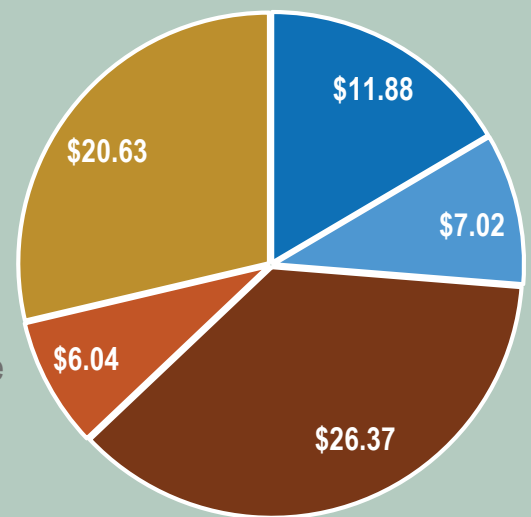
Explanation of Charges: Residential Customers

- **Water Usage:** The cost of service for each centum cubic foot* (CCF) of water used during a billing period. Your usage is based on the monthly meter reading at your home.
- **Sewerage Disposal:** The cost to collect, treat and dispose of raw sewage for each CCF of water used during a billing period.
- **Drainage Charge**:** A monthly amount for cost related to the collection and treatment of stormwater as required by Federal and State laws. The charge is calculated by either a meter rate or an impervious acreage rate (all residential customers will be on the impervious rate as of October 2017).
- **Water Service Charge**:** A fixed monthly amount based on meter size to cover the cost of the meter, billing, and providing customer service.
- **Sewerage Service Charge**:** A fixed monthly amount to cover the following:
 - **Operations, Maintenance, and Repair Charges (OM&R):** Amount for day-to-day customer service and maintenance operations.
 - **Capital Charges:** Cost of improving and expanding meters, service centers, and equipment.
