Objective

Reduce the number of repeat 9-1-1 calls related to Squatter Disturbances by 50%, from 25 to 13, with out negatively impacting the quality of service.

Scope

In Scope: 911 calls related to Squatter Disturbances.


Out of Scope: All other 911 calls.
Squatter complaints reported via other methods.

Opportunities for Improvement

- Officers struggle with the SOP for squatter callsvague and ineffective
- » Hours officers spend on scene
- » Squatter calls result in officers time being taken away from other priorities
- » Data related to squatters not collected

Improvements

Key Changes

Process

- » Scrapped the old "process" and developed an all new process
- » Chief's Neighborhood Liaison Office staff training file development, data tracking, SmartSheet usage, etc.
- » NPO's trained to deal with various squatter scenarios, including Chief's Neighborhood Liaison Office and DPD Law for differentiating between criminal and civil.

Technology

- » DoIT added "Squatter Issues" to SeeClickFix/ Improve Detroit and created a squatter SmartSheet
- » DoIT trained Chief's Neighborhood Liaison Office and NPOs on new technology

Collaboration

- » Involved DPD Law early in the process to help make on scene decisions
- » Worked with Wayne County Deed Fraud task force




At the start of the project, Oct. 2017, officers were spending 59.05 hours at the scene of squatter related 9-1-1 calls. May 2018, they spent 19.59 hours, a 66.82% reduction

Hours Officers Spent On Scene for Squatter Calls per Month 5 Start of Project October 2017 60 44.98 44.76 44.98 44.76 38.15 37.26 38.68 37.26 May 2018 Reduction = 66.82%

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Results



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At the start of the project, Oct 2017, there were 25 repeat emergency 9-1-1 calls* related to squatter complaints. May 2018, there were 10, a 60% reduction.
