



The City of Detroit Department of Public Works is making improvements regarding solid waste services.


Beginning June 3, all collections (garbage, bulk, yard waste and recycling) will be occuring on the same day.

> The limit for bulk items increases to 2 cubic yards.

All items must be placed at the curb the night before or prior to 7 a.m. on your designated collection day (see map above).

GARBAGE / Pickup is once a week.

- All garbage should be bagged and placed in the container.
- Place container within 4 feet of the curb with handle facing toward the residential unit and away from the
- Please place in front of all other waste to ensure access by automated collection vehicles.

■ Place container at least 3 feet away from all other objects such as mailbox, car, recycling cart, etc.

RECYCLING / Pickup is every other week on the same day as your garbage collection.

The City encourages all residents to recycle.

- Residents must register for this service by visiting www.AdvancedDisposal.com/DetroitResidential or by calling (844) 2-DETROIT (233-8764).
- There is a one-time fee of \$25 per household.
- For information on how to obtain a free recycling container, go to detroitrecycles.org.
- Place container within 4 feet of the curb with handle facing toward the residential unit and away from the street. Please place in front of all other waste to ensure access by automated collection vehicles.
- Place container at least 3 feet away from all other objects such as mailbox, car, garbage cart, etc.

BULK WASTE / Pickup is every other week on the same day as your garbage collection.

- Residents are now allowed up to 2 cubic yards of bulk items per pickup which is approximately the size of a sofa or two stoves.
- Items accepted for pickup would not fit in an empty garbage container.
- Items NOT ACCEPTED: Construction and demolition debris, hazardous waste, other unacceptable waste materials (see Website)
- Prior to disposal, all liquids, food, chlorofluorocarbons (CFCs), polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs), and any unacceptable waste must be removed from bulk waste items and appliances.

YARD WASTE / Pickup is every other week on the same day as your garbage collection.

- Pickup is now every other week for 36 weeks per year. Yard waste collection usually begins in April and runs through mid-December. Please check for updates and specific dates at www. AdvancedDisposal.com/DetroitResidential
- Yard waste must be bagged in biodegradable paper bags or bundles. NO PLASTIC BAGS WILL BE ACCEPTED.
- Brush must not be longer than 4 feet in length or larger than 2 inches in diameter.
- Items accepted for pickup include: leaves, grass clippings, tree branches and twigs (Tied and bundled, no more than 60 lbs.).
- Items NOT ACCEPTED: garbage, large tree debris, tree stumps, soil or dirt.
- Christmas tree pickup is the first two weeks in January. Christmas trees must not contain any decorations or materials made of nonorganic material

CONTAINER REPLACEMENT OR NEW SERVICE START-UP

Please contact Customer Care at **(844) 2-DETROIT (233-8764)**. Residents will need to pay a one-time fee of \$25 per container for replacement or the start of new service.
