THE 2019-2020 HOMELESSNESS SOLUTIONS PROGRAM RFP TO APPLY FOR EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANT (ESG) AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FUNDS

The City of Detroit invites homeless service provider organizations to submit proposals for projects to be funded by the 2019-2020 Homelessness Solutions (CDBG/ESG) program as funded through the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD).

All non-profit organizations that wish to provide homelessness prevention, street outreach, emergency shelter or rapid rehousing services may submit proposals.

In the 2019-2020 program year, all proposals must be prepared and submitted online using the City's "BidSync" system. Proposal applicants must register on BidSync before a proposal can be submitted. Proposals must be submitted via BidSync by 4:00 pm on Monday, June 24, 2019. Paper copies of Proposals will not be accepted. Proposals submitted by Monday, June 24, 2019 deadline will be evaluated by city agencies. **Late proposals will not be accepted.** Funding awards will be determined by the Mayor and City Council.

The 2019-2020 Homelessness Solutions proposal packages with the required proposal forms will be available via BidSync on Monday, May 20, 2019.
