




# Introduction to the Bond Program

- Funding to support transformative streetscape projects throughout the city
  - 5-Year program, approx. 26 projects
  - \$80 million to fund design and construction
- Focused on revitalizing retail corridors
  - Tied to Neighborhood Framework Plans






# Introduction to the Project

## McNichols Streetscape (Livernois to Wyoming)

- Budget: \$2.78M
- Key project elements:
  - Repaved roadway
  - New sidewalks
  - New lighting
  - New street trees
  - Two-way cycle track
  - Enhanced bus stops
  - Safer ped crossings (11 new crossings)
  - Designated on-street parking spaces








# Next Steps

- Project extended to Wyoming
  - Repaved roadway
  - Two-way cycle track
  - Safer pedestrian crossings
  - Designated on-street parking spaces
  - Enhanced bus stops
- Develop plan to maintain traffic and business access during construction
- Develop a one-block alley parking pilot
- Continue coordination with property owners, Marygrove, UDM
- Selection of tree species and amenities
