

2018

- 48 random dates were selected and reviewed.
- 102 Corrective Action Notices were sent to various Commands due to no event being captured.

Conducted Energy Weapon

 A device that uses propelled wires or direct contact to conduct energy to affect the sensory and motor functions of the nervous system. CEWs are a lessthan-lethal device used to gain control of actively aggressive subjects or those who pose a risk to themselves or others.
