

Reduced Fare Card for Riders with Disabilities



WHO QUALIFIES?

- Individuals with any injury or disability that physically or cognitively limits mobility independence.
- Medicare card holders.*

* Eligible to receive the reduced fare of \$0.50 by showing a Medicare card to the bus operator.

VERIFICATION

Applicants must provide photo ID (driver's license, state ID, Detroit ID, or passport) and complete a Reduced Fare Application and a Professional Verification Form completed by a health care professional.



HOW TO APPLY?



Complete a Reduced Fare ID Card Application in one of the following ways:

By Phone. Call (313) 578-8268 to request one be mailed to you.

In-Person. Pick up an application Monday – Friday, 11:30 a.m. – 3 p.m., at any of these locations:

- Rosa Parks Transit Center
- Northwest Activities Center
- Butzel Family Center

Accessibility

DDOT has never been more accessible. Fixed-route buses are equipped with:

- Kneels to lower the front of the bus for easier boarding.
- Ramp and lift-equipped to accommodate wheelchairs and other mobility devices.



Detroit MetroLift Service is available to those who have a disability that prevents them from using DDOT's fixed-route services. It is a shared ride service provided within $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile of the DDOT fixed-route service area.
