Accessibility

DDOT has never been more accessible. Fixed-route buses are equipped with:

- Kneels to lower the front of the bus for easier boarding.
- Ramp and lift-equipped to accommodate wheelchairs and other mobility devices.



Detroit Metrol ift Service is available to those who have a disability that prevents them from using DDOT's fixedroute services. It is a shared ride service provided within 34 of a mile of the DDOT fixed-route service area.
