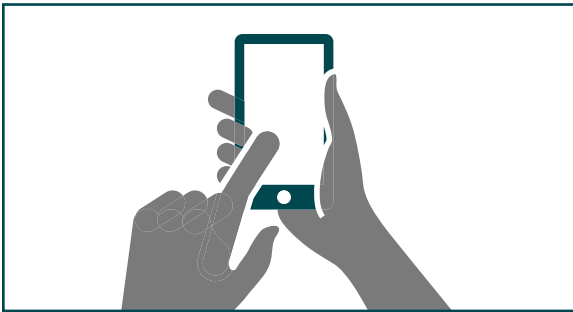


RIDING DDOT BUSES IS EASY

Is this your first time riding on a DDOT bus? Whether it is your first time or you need a refresher about riding the bus, use these tips to get started.

1 Plan Ahead



Visit www.ridedetroittransit.com for useful tools to help plan your trip.

- The Transit App is available to download at Apple's App Store and on Google Play for real-time planning and information.
- Text your location to TextMyBus at **50464** to find buses near your location in real-time.
- Arrive at the bus stop at least five minutes before the scheduled time.

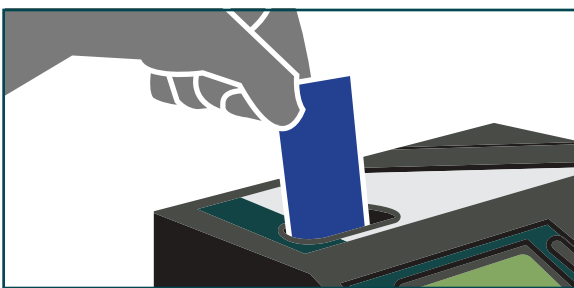
2 Boarding the Bus



Stand near the bus sign (bus stops are usually located every two-to-three blocks along each route).

- As the bus approaches, check the destination sign above the windshield. If you have a question about the route, ask the driver before boarding.
- Have your fare, pass, and identification card ready when you board.

3 Pay Your Fare



The 4- and 24-hour Dart Passes can be purchased on the bus. Tell your driver before you pay for fare using bills or coins. Must use exact change.

These groups are eligible for a reduced fare:

- Seniors (ages 65 and older).
- People with disabilities.
- Medicare recipients.
- Students with a school-issued ID.

An application is required.

4 Exiting the Bus



Signal to stop the bus by pulling the cord near the windows.

- Signal at least one block before your stop.
- Major stops and intersections are announced. If you are not familiar with the area, you can ask the driver to announce your destination.
- Exit through the rear door.
