



Detroit Public Schools Renewal Millage



The renewal only applies to owners of rental properties, business properties and vacation homes –

homeowner's property taxes will not be increased.

What is the DPS Millage Renewal

- A fiscally responsible proposal and every dollar will be tracked to ensure transparency, accountability and that taxpayer dollars are spent wisely.
- The operating millage renewal is a continuation of the current operating millage that levies 18 mills on non-homestead properties.
- The revenue from the millage supports day-to-day operations from ensuring students have the skills they need to compete for jobs to providing much-needed wraparound services to ensure the physical and mental safety and security of our students, families and our community.

How will the operating millage renewal help our City?

- Provide students the critical skills they need to get good paying jobs,
- Ensure students are career and college-ready so they can compete in the global marketplace, including the skilled trades, and
- Promote a safe return to school for students following the COVID-19

 increased cleaning and sanitation to protect public health.




