

City of Detroit Climate Strategy Overview

Purpose & Justification

The impacts of the global climate crisis are already manifesting locally for Detroit residents. In July 2019, City Council passed a Greenhouse Gas (GHG) ordinance mandating emissions reductions from both municipal operations and community-wide sources. The City has an obligation to our residents to proactively prepare for climate impacts and create a more resilient Detroit.

Goals & Objectives

- Update municipal and city-wide GHG assessment
- Increase City and community capacity to prepare for and address the impacts of climate
- Develop a data driven Climate Mitigation Strategy for municipal and citywide emissions
- Create an equity-centered Climate Strategy
- Normalize the practice of including climate mitigation and resilience considerations into internal and external decision-making and actions
- Build internal and external tools to continuously evaluate climate strategies through an equity lens.

Components

- Greenhouse Gas Assessment
 - o Internal and external benchmarking of GHG emissions
 - o Development of GHG reporting tools & annual report to City Council
 - o Develop climate mitigation strategies for municipal and community-wide emissions
- Climate Vulnerability Assessment
 - o Indicators to assess impacts exposure, sensitivity, and adaptive capacity at census tract level
 - o Integration into hazard mitigation plans and equity assessments
- Internal and External Engagement in planning process
 - o Internal: Interdepartmental, Climate Mitigation, and Resilience Workgroups
 - External: Climate Equity Committee, Ambassador Organizations, pilot project grants, citywide forums, focus groups, and sector specific outreach (business, intuitions, community benefits organizations)
- Outputs
 - o Inform Hazards Mitigation and City Operation Plans
 - o Develop Community Resiliency Toolkit
 - o Create Climate Mitigation and overarching Climate Action Strategies
