DETECTIVE BUREAU



- **Detective Bureau**
 - The Detective Bureau is responsible for the efficient and proper operations of the following commands:
 - Investigative Operations
 - Major Crimes
 - Organized Crimes

- **Investigative Operations**
 - Conducts criminal investigations of crimes committed within the precincts

- **Major Crimes**
 - Has the primary responsibility to work in coordination with specialized commands, precincts and other agencies to arrest and prosecute individuals that commit violent crimes

- **Organized Crimes**
 - Has the primary responsibility to investigate offenses such as; corruption, extortion, bribery, narcotics and other organized criminal activity

HOMICIDE

- **Homicide**
 - Respond to and investigate all homicides, including infant deaths, suicides, and unnatural deaths (other than homicides)
- **Fatal Squad**
 - Respond to and investigate fatal and critical vehicular accidents
- **Inactive Case Squad**
 - Review and investigate cases that have been classified as having no further investigative follow-up with the goal of identifying new investigate leads
- **Headquarters Surveillance**
 - Apprehend murder / violent crime suspects
- **Missing Persons**
 - Identify endangered and long-term missing persons
- **Arson**
 - Joint Police / Fire Department team



SPECIAL VICTIMS UNIT

- **Domestic Violence**
 - Married, formerly or currently reside together and child in common
- **Sex Crimes**
 - Unknown (Stranger) squad
 - Known squad
 - Child squad
 - SAK squad
- **Child Abuse**
 - Respond to and investigate all allegations of child abuse regarding victims age 16 and under

AUTO THEFT / PUBLIC ORDER CRIMES

- Auto Theft Unit
 - Carjackings
 - Stolen Vehicles
 - Auto Parts Inspections
- Public Order Crimes
 - Dumping
 - Electricity Theft
 - Scrapping
 - Graffiti
 - Cyber Crimes

Crime Intelligence Unit (CIU)

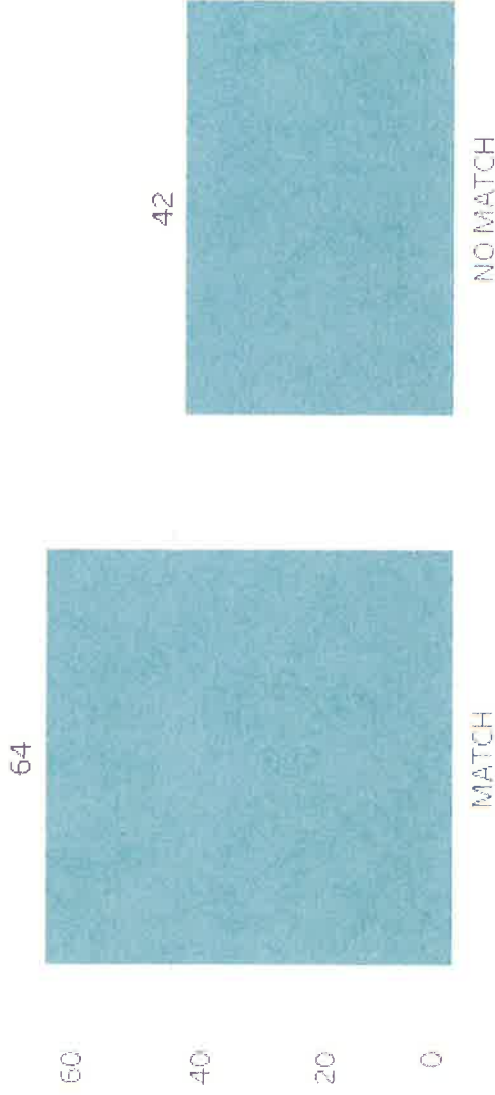


- **Real Time Crime Center (RTCC)**
 - The RTCC serves as the home for both the Crime Intelligence Unit and the Traffic Management Center. The space is currently under construction.
- **Project Greenlight (PGL) Team**
 - PGL is a public-private-community partnership wherein businesses enter into an agreement with DPD to provide the department access to real-time video footage at the location in exchange for DPD staff devoted to effectively receive, monitor, and analyze video feeds. There are currently 702 businesses participating in the PGL program.
- **Counterterrorism Threat Analysis Team (CTAT)**
 - CTAT is tasked with ongoing threat assessments as it relates to domestic and foreign terrorism, particularly in relation to the City of Detroit.
- **Audio Video Extraction Response Team (AVERT)**
 - AVERT is a response unit that is responsible for the extraction and preservation of audio and visual evidence of crimes being committed. AVERT is also responsible for the determination of PGLD camera placement and compliance.

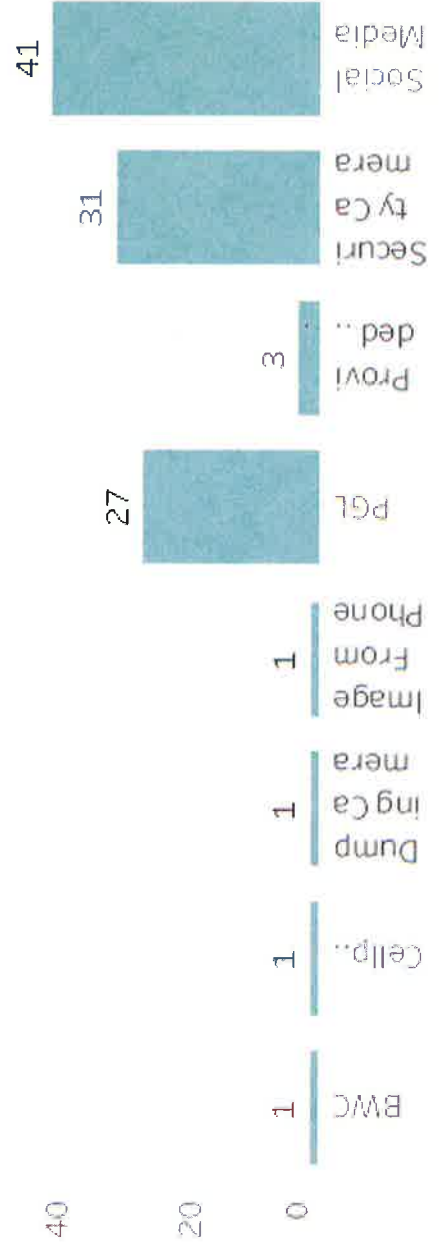
Crime Intelligence Unit (CIU)
