- Requirement of Investigative Commands to secure and activate BWCs when executing search warrants or effecting an arrest
- Procedures Regarding Assignment of BWCs and Supervisory Responsibilities

- Described Use of BWCs for Members Assigned to a Task Force with Federal Partners
- Itemized Decisions/Procedures for Release of Video Footage through FOIA (Freedom of Information Act) Regarding Federal Task Force Investigations
- Outlined Supervisors Responsibility to Audit and Inspect BWCs before and after the shift
- Releasing BWCs Footage Requires Written Approval of Chief of Police or Professional Standards Bureau
- Additional Training Requirements
