It gathers information about Detroit's **Parks**


- + Rec Centers

 - The Census (about seniors, youth, population density, etc.)
 - **Residents'** priorities
 - Surveys of parks & rec centers current conditions and needs
 - And national best practices

and creates a vision for the future that determines parks & rec investments and priorities for the next 5-10 years

WHY IS IT IMPORTANT?

- It gives residents a voice in determining the future of parks & rec in Detroit
- 2 It determines where future funding will go, such as
 - Park renovations
 - Rec center repairs
 - Swim/fitness classes
 - Summer day camps

- 3 It can make changes to the parks & rec system with
 - New parks
 - Greenway connections
 - Expanded rec center services
- 4 It allows the City to get grants and other funding
