The City and the Detroit Building Authority (DBA) have established a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) stating that all contracts between the City and the DBA will no longer include separate indemnity provisions, and instead the terms of the MOA will govern indemnification between the City, the DBA, and related parties providing services to either entity.

- 3. What are the issues that may arise that will trigger a request for legal representation and indemnification for an agent of the Detroit Building Authority?
- 4. What is the projected number of legal representation and indemnification requests that will be submitted to the Detroit City Council annually?
- 5. How much money has been paid out relative to legal claims against the Detroit Building Authority or any authority board members, directors, authority employees, or personal service contractors?
- 6. Under what circumstances will the Detroit Building Authority deny a request for legal representation and indemnification?
- 7. Please provide a detailed list of all current Detroit Building Authority projects.
