That are safe


19%

of responses mentioned the need for safety improvements on their streets. Of these, there were **102** specific references to the safety of pedestrians or cyclists.



Free of speeders

1 The number 1 survey response, from **28%** of all responses, was directed at addressing speeding on Detroit's streets! "live on local streets with long straight stretches that give drivers the opportunity to speed"



Vibrant & inviting

11%

of responses mentioned wanting streets that are **inviting, well designed and encourage people to be outside!** For example, one respondent hopes for "less lanes and more room for walking, biking, outdoor dining, and congregating"

Accessible on foot


7%

of responses mentioned the need for improved pedestrian facilities. These responses touched on the full range of pedestrian improvements including fixing cracks in sidewalks, adding crosswalk striping, and installing blinking flashing lights.
