 - Please sign up for MITN if you have not done so already. MITN does have 2 options a free version where a contractor needs to watch for bids, or a paid version which will notify you of all new solicitations that fall under the NIGP codes* that you signed up for.
 (*NIGP Code is a universal taxonomy for identifying commodities and services in procurement systems)
- Obtain Clearances from the City of Detroit (A mandatory minimum qualification to be considered responsive)
- Apply for Certifications through the Civil Rights, Inclusion & Opportunity (CRIO) Organization
 which may qualify your business for Equalization Credits (competitive advantage) as permitted by
 DWSD Procurement Policy permits.
- Registration into the City of Detroit's Supplier Portal allows the award and subsequent payment processes to go quicker and we can issue Purchase Orders and process invoices for payment efficiently.
