

Overview of Project

The Far West Detroit Stormwater Improvement Project will include drainage improvements and water and sewer upgrades. Work will take place within the neighborhood as well as in Rouge Park. Residents can expect to see water main replacement, lead service line replacement as needed, downspout disconnections as needed, and sewer repairs. The work performed in Rouge Park will result in north and south basins as well as new connections to existing trails throughout the park. The stormwater basins will allow for filtration and slowly release flow to the Rouge River.

Schedule and Phasing

Phase 1: The graphic below shows where work will be located *during the first year of the project*. Stormwater work will begin in the summer in Rouge Park. Water main work is proposed to start on the southwest side of the neighborhood and work east, then north. Street impacts will be to intersections for water main connections. Road work will be to utility trench repairs.



Phases 2, 3 and 4: The later phases of the plan will take place *during years 2-5 of the project*, and will include the following work:

- » Storm and sanitary sewer work on Majestic in 2023
- » Storm and sanitary sewer work will occur on Sawyer in 2024
- » Half-width construction on adjacent streets in 2025-2026
