

WHAT WE HEARD FROM YOU

- Maintenance & Repairs!
 - Walking path broken surfaces & flooding
 - Baseball regrading, fencing, seating, drainage, leaves
 - Tennis courts surfaces
- Additions!
 - More playground equipment
 - More picnic amenities
 - More seating
 - Emphasis on natural elements
 - More programming in open spaces
- Other safety concerns:
 - Undesired behaviors, driving through the park, littering, after hours use, vandalism, substance use



WHAT WE HEARD FROM YOU - PRIORITIES



Love the walking paths! Need to fix the **flooding** Love the baseball diamonds and nearby play amenities! Needs **repairs** and **playground expansion**







How Much Can We Do Now?



Must Haves:

Walking paths:

- + remove & replace paths
- + flooding remediation
- + baseball field work & tennis court repair
- + picnic shelter

total <mark>\$360 k</mark>

Decision Points:

<u>Nature playground</u> + 2 small areas OR + 1 large area OR <u>+ swing set</u>

total <mark>\$50 k</mark>

Picnic & other amenities

- + picnic tables by tennis.....\$6 k
- + game table by tennis.....\$6 k
- + benches near basketball.....\$4 k
- + picnic shelter extension.....\$10 k
