Welcome to the City of Detroit's Recycling Initiative

Follow this checklist to create a successful recycling program:

Review this guide
Place each recycling container next to a trash container
Post the enclosed "Recycle Only" and "Trash Only" signs at eye-level above respective containers
Post "Want to Recycle at Home?" flyer where Detroiters will see it
Post the "Recycling Schedule" sign where your custodial staff can easily find it
Reach out to your Recycling Coordinator if you have any questions or issues with your recycling service

Setting Up Recycling Containers



Recycling Bin (18-gallons)

- Use for interior collection
- Empty contents into cart or dumpster for collection



Recycling Cart (96-gallons)

- Interior or exterior
- Roll this cart around your facility to collect materials from interior bins
- Serviced by DPW on your collection day



Recycling Dumpster (450-gallons)

- Exterior only
- Serviced by DPW on your collection day

Recycling Tips

- All recyclables should be placed **loosely inside your cart** not on top or around it
- All recyclables **go into the same container** our recycling is "single stream"
- **Secure your containers** properly there may be a fee for stolen containers
- When we drop off your containers, we will show you exactly where to place the containers for service
- Ensure the **path to your recycling container is clear** if our truck cannot access your container, we may not service it
- Place your containers outside by 7am on your service day. Pull them back and secure them by 9pm on your service day.

Avoiding Contamination

When in doubt, throw it out!

Non-recyclable materials **CONTAMINATE** our recycling.

Contamination causes problems at the recycling facility.

This is why it is critical to **RECYCLE RIGHT!**

- ☐ Train your staff and tenants on proper recycling
- □ Place trash and recycling bins side-by-side in a visible location
- □ Post the Detroit Recycles signage at eye-level
- ☐ Monitor your recycling bins, especially in the beginning





What to do if you spot contamination:

- 1. Empty the contents into the trash
- 2. Place a trash can right next to the recycling container
- 3. Place our helpful signage at eye-level above both containers
- 4. Consider moving the container to a less-public area
- 5. Contact your Recycling Coordinator, who can help you problem-solve
