



CHANDLER PLAYGROUND IMPROVEMENT TIMELINE



COMFORT STATION AREA: LARGE PLAYGROUND AREA WITH NET CLIMBERS, TALL TOWER AND SLIDE, PLAY MOUNDS WITH CLIMBING AND SLIDING ELEMENTS EMBEDDED, TODDLER PLAY STRUCTURE, TRADITIONAL AND BASKET SWINGS, SEATING AREAS

PICNIC AREA WITH ONE MEDIUM AND ONE SMALL SHELTER SIDE-BY-SIDE THAT COULD BE USED TOGETHER OR SEPARATELY, AND ADDITIONAL TABLES NEAR

What We Heard


- Preferred one larger playground and smaller nature play area
- Picnic shelter should be near playground but not right next to it to avoid conflict use
- Separate toddler play area from school-age area
- Like nature play near marshland vs. old tennis courts
- Medium shelter near "senior area" instead of large
- Bold ang bright color palette
- Make shelters different colors so they can be easily identified
- Small shelter at corner of Conner and Chandler Park Dr.
- Push playground further from street




