The program transforms neighborhoods of concentrated poverty into mixed-income neighborhoods of long-term viability by revitalizing severely distressed public and/or assisted housing; improving access to economic opportunities; and investing/leveraging investments in well-functioning services, effective schools/education programs, public assets, public transportation, and improved access to jobs. Goals are housing, improved outcomes for people, and neighborhood investment.

This Transformation Plan was developed through an 18-month planning process led jointly by HRD and the Planning and Development Department (PDD).
