Wanted Activities / Spaces (percentage of respondents who reported wanting the amenity)


- Community meeting spaces 91.2%



Concessions (purchase food) – do vou want this at the new rec center? ^{88 responses}




Barber & Beauty Salon - do you want this at the new rec center?

Highest Priority Activities / Spaces (percent of respondents choosing the amenity in their top 3)

- Fitness Center 57%
- Gymnasium 51%
- Computer Lab / Internet Access 51%
- Community Meeting Spaces 46%
- Cooking & Health Classes 33%
- Dance & Aerobics 30%
- STEM Classroom 25%
- Reading Room 16%
- Arts & Crafts 16%
- Concessions 10%
- Barber / Beauty Salon 10%
- Laundry Facility 7%

What we've been working on

Conceptual layout to fit ALL wanted amenities, looking for feedback on the rooms, sizes, and layout.

FOOD FOR THOUGHT:

- Combining some compatible uses into multipurpose spaces (ie computer lab & classroom)
- Providing flexible space to adapt to future uses/wants
- Improving access from the parking lot to the building & existing pools


