Tracey Rucker





Phase IIA: Preserve on Ash I & II Several blocks along 14th and Ash St, just South of Martin Luther King Ir. Blvd

Phase IIB: North Corktown Preserve Estates Home Ownership Directly East of Preserve on Ash I &II, West of Wabash St along Ash St.

Phase III: Clement Kern Gardens Located on Bagley St, between Rosa Parks Blvd and Trumbull Ave

Phase IV: The Bridge Between Rosa Parks Blvd and Cochrane St, directly West of Left Field

Phase V: Bagley Homeownership Northwest corner of Bagley St and Wabash St, about two blocks West of Clement Kern Gardens


