Residential Parking Permit Update – Brush Park

In 2019, Detroit City Council voted to establish a Residential Parking Permit program to allow neighborhoods with significant parking burden to petition to establish a permitted parking area. On September 23, 2022, the Brush Park CDC submitted a petition for a Residential Parking Permit Area, but has yet to receive notification of receipt of the petition. Please provide a report with the following:

- Has DPW received the petition from the Brush Park CDC?
- Has DPW began a review of the Brush Park petition?
- How long does DPW have to review the petition and submit a report to Municipal Parking?
- Has the Municipal Parking Department initiated a parking study?
- How many Residential Parking Permit petitions have been submitted since adoption of the ordinance?
- How many Residential Parking Permit areas have been established since adoption of the ordinance?
