RE: 2023-2024 Department of Elections Budget Questions

The office of Council Member Angela Calloway respectfully submits the following questions to the Department of Elections as a part of the 2023-2024 budget hearing process.

- 1. **QUESTION**: Detroit continues to rank the lowest amongst major cities for eligible voter participation in both local, state, and national elections
 - a. What is the strategy to improve our Get Out to Vote efforts? Increase voter engagement across all age groups? And specifically target our non-voters and would be first time and second time voters? This group includes our young adults.
 - b. Does the City Clerk's office support automatic voter registration?
- 2. **QUESTION**: The FY 2024 budget proposes \$470,000 for Voter Education & Outreach. Please describe what your "aggressive voter outreach programs" are and how they have changed since the pandemic.
- 3. **QUESTION**: Please describe what the software for managing poll workers is and what it does. Also, please explain what the proposed additional funding for poll workers is going to pay for.
- 4. **QUESTION:** Please explain how you are preparing for the 2024 and the 2025 election cycles considering the current vacancy rate in your department. Do you anticipate having all necessary positions filled?
