





A \$3 million road reconstruction project in collaboration with DPW

COMING FEATURES:


- Improved vehicular circulation (partial two-way stretch)
- Protected bike lanes / shared-use loop path
- Grass/planted median

UPDATED TIMELINE:

- Construction will be underway from early May until late August
- The park will be closed to vehicular traffic during this time, but open to foot traffic.




