## RE: REQUEST FOR INFORMATION ON VARIOUS PORT AUTHORITY INITIATIVES AND PLANS

As part of the ongoing budget sessions, I kindly request that the Detroit Port Authority provide detailed responses to the following questions related to ongoing and proposed initiatives:

- 1. Identify the return on investment for the proposed \$430K bollard to be used by private shipping companies.
- 2. Please submit your decarbonization plan to Detroit City Council.
- 3. Provide the specifications for the proposed hydrokinetic energy harvester, including the amount of energy to be produced by this machine.
- 4. Provide the net present value of \$1m 1980 dollars in 2023.
- 5. Describe the process to remove the Port Authority from the Master Concession Agreement.
- 6. Please identify the ability of the Port Authority to work with the ship construction industry to locate a shipbuilding facility within Detroit along the Detroit River.
- 7. Has the Port Authority completed a strategic plan? If so, please submit a copy to City Council.

Your timely response to these questions will greatly assist the City Council in evaluating and making informed decisions during the budget sessions. I would appreciate receiving your responses by April 2, 2023.
