- 6. How often does CRIO engage in compliance efforts to ensure that employers are complying with various city mandates, such as Executive Order 2021-02 or Community Benefit Agreements?
- 7. Which divisions within the department staff compliance officers?
- 8. What is the difference between inspectors and compliance officers?
