RE: Neighborhood Enterprise Zone Certificate Application for the construction of a new single-family house at 4445 17th Street in the Core City Neighborhood Enterprise Zone area (RECOMMEND APPROVAL)

The office of the City Clerk forwarded to the City Planning Commission (CPC) an application requesting a 15-year Neighborhood Enterprise Zone (NEZ) certificate for the construction of a single-family house at 4445 17th Street.

The petitioners are Nicholas Dowgwillo and Laura Amtower who plan to build and reside in the house. The property is vacant land on the west side of 17th Street between Buchanan and West Forest Avenues.

The applicants are proposing to build a single-family house containing 1,050 square feet with 2 bedrooms and 2 bathrooms. The estimated project cost is \$316,000.

The subject property has been confirmed as being within the boundaries of the Core City NEZ, which was established by City Council on November 16, 2004 and should be eligible for NEZ certificate under the State NEZ Act (Act 147 of 1992) as currently written.

The NEZ Act (Act 147 of 1992) states the application for the certificate must be filed before a building permit is issued. However, the NEZ Act allows a certificate to be filed not later than 6 months following the date the building permit is issued provided the local government allows by resolution. The petitioner indicates the building permit issued October 20, 2022, and the certificate was applied for afterwards on March 30, 2023.

CPC staff has reviewed the application and recommends approval. Attached is a resolution for Your consideration. Please contact our office should you have any questions.

WHEREAS, Michigan Public Act 147 of 1992 allows the local legislative body to establish Neighborhood Enterprise Zones for the purpose of providing exemption from ad valorem property taxes, and the imposition of specific tax in lieu of ad valorem taxes; and
