

What we've heard: Rec Center Survey Results


Wanted Activities / Spaces (percentage of respondents who reported wanting the amenity)


Wanted Activities (percentage of respondents who reported wanting the amenity)

Master Plan



- A. Remove asphalt, fencing, light posts, basketball hoops, parking blocks, etc. In existing park/parking lot space.
- B. Close Tuxedo between the rec center and park to create a plaza space, safer access
- C. Create and beautify vacant lots with a grassland/meadow/pollinator habitat including walkways and site furniture.
- D. Remove and replace deteriorated concrete alley; increase parking behind the rec center and add parking behind proposed park




