

Media Services Department Detroit Film Office Film Permit Information Guide

Prior to obtaining a film permit from the Detroit Film Office, there may be prior approvals needed. Based on the request, the following information will aid in the film application process.

Any prior approvals that have been confirmed need to be emailed to dfo@detroitmi.gov if they were not provided during the application process.

Please note that once you receive a prior approval, you are not approved to film until you have received your film permit from this department.

ITC/Police Hours

Once connected with a DPD representative, an invoice will be forwarded to you from DPD Tactical Operations Unit. The invoice must be fulfilled prior to filming to confirm adequate manpower.

Police are required to be on the scene if you are using prop weapons for any exterior filming.

Drones

UAS (Unmanned Aircraft System) operations requires a Part 107 certificate. The Flight Standards District Office phone number is 734-487-7222. You will need a waiver from the FAA (Federal Aviation Administration) for the dates and times you wish to fly. https://www.faa.gov/uas/commercial_operators/part_107_waivers

Submit a film permit application to the Detroit Film Office, along with the submitting the pilots drone license as well as the drone serial number.

Buildings and Safety Engineering and Environmental Department (BSEED)

- A permit is required for tents larger than 10x10
- A permit is required for any sized generator that requires fuel; therefore combustible.
- A permit is required for use of a condor, crane or scissor lift type equipment- as these are considered "special use" items.

If instructed to complete a Temporary Use Application for a permit, please plan for at least 1-2 weeks for review and processing.
