Fall Construction Quarterly Meeting Update


On September 19, residents from the Far West Detroit neighborhood gathered for the DWSD quarterly community construction meeting to discuss the project progress. **DWSD would like to thank everyone who attended the meeting and contributed to the conversation. DWSD values your feedback and uses it to help ensure that our contracting team is aware of community concerns.** Key concerns expressed by the community included:


- Improving notifications for planned water service interruptions.
- Prioritizing the replacement of water main on Parkland south of Tireman.
- Restoring areas impacted by 2023 construction work and making sure that site cleanup is performed by the contractor.




Construction Progress

DWSD contractors have made significant progress on construction activities. With the exception of the remaining section on Parkland Street, all planned water main upgrades within the neighborhood are substantially complete. DWSD contractors have also performed sewer rehabilitation throughout the neighborhood. Drainage and stormwater upgrades continue with substantial work wrapping up on Majestic. The contractor will focus efforts in the coming weeks on pavement and lawn restoration along Parkland Street.







Parkland Street Water Main

Earlier this year, the water main along Parkland Street between Tireman and Warren experienced several water main breaks. This portion of water main was not originally scheduled for replacement. However, based on the number of breaks and the impacts to residents, DWSD has added this section of water main to its emergency replacement schedule. We anticipate that work will begin by the end of the year pending the approval from the State of Michigan which regulates water main **construction.** Once State approval is received, residents will be notified.


Attend our Project Progress Meetings
