- All events free to the public
- Only food trucks and vendors at cost.
 Total Access Events (TAE), on behalf of Detroit Rec, hires event suppliers based on programming plans developed by Detroit Rec. TAE also books food trucks.
- Dry Vendors are selected by Detroit Rec.

- In collaboration with Detroit Rec, Total Access Events hires suppliers and books food trucks and dry vendors on behalf of Detroit Rec.

How to Become a City of Detroit Vendor?

- Vendors must be licensed to sale by the Buildings, Safety, Engineering and Environmental Department. (BSEED)
- Vendor License is \$115 per event.
- This process is managed by the BSEED licensing division.

- The General Services Department does not have authority or input in vendor selling outside of recreation assets: city parks and recreation centers.
- It is strictly prohibited for vendors to pull up and sale at city parks.
- Vendors must be scheduled or booked by an event organizer.
- Event Organizers: Groups that host events in city parks.
 - City Departments
 - Community Groups
 - Organizations
 - Businesses
 - Sororities, Fraternities, etc.




General Services Department-Licensed Vendor List

- In 2022, Total Access Events (TAE) launched an equitable process to lessen the cost for dry vendors and food trucks to do business at Spirit Plaza due to the multiple bookings throughout the season.
- The General Services Department in collaboration with the Buildings, Safety, Engineering and Environmental Department, the Health Department and the Fire Department expanded on the TAE process to lessen the cost to do business in city parks, city recreation centers and at Spirit Plaza.
- As the administering agency, the General Services Department is an event organizer during the peak event season, April-October.
- This allows vendors to pay the license fee one time for the season rather than each they that they are hired.
- Once payment is made, approved vendors are added to the licensed vendors list to be booked by the General Services Department, other departments and other event organizers.



Licensed Vendor List Process







How do you get on the licensed vendor list?

Mobile Food Units

- Must have:
 - A valid form of identification
 - An up-to-date fire and health permit
 - Pictures of your mobile food unit

Dry Vendors

- Must have:
 - A valid form of identification
 - Pictures of the items that you want approval to sale

Non-Mobile Food Units

- Businesses selling convenience items, baked goods, etc. are not eligible for the licensed vendor list.
 - These business are still allowed to be booked by an event organizer. However, they are not eligible for the licensed vendor list due to health and safety relative to public food consumption.





Scheduling

- The General Services Department only schedules vendors for departmental events at city parks, recreation centers and at Spirit Plaza.
- Other event organizers receive the list and book at their needs.

Scheduling

- The General Services Department events team schedules vendors for annual calendar events, Spirit Plaza and for event park partners.
- Recreation center staff schedules vendors for recreation center events.
