

Relocation Process!





Mark Your Calendars: We are extremely excited to announce the anticipated completion of Left Field is dated for the end of May. Please share in this excitement with the ACD and IMS staff at their 1st Friday meetings, where you will learn more about the upcoming units and the relocation experience. Residents in Buildings 11 and 12 (units 1511-1567) will have the first opportunity to transition over to Left Field, shortly after completion. As we move closer to the completion of Left Field, please keep a look out for the next round of correspondence from the IMS/TCB-CL staff.

What important information should I know about the relocation process?

All Clement Kern Gardens residents will receive a notice 6 months and again 90 days before the anticipated relocation date. The notices will be phased by building based on the demolition schedule. IMS will conduct 1-on-1 in-person meetings with all residents with the purpose of communicating the details of the moving process and future opportunities for residency. No one is required to move at this time.

What should I do if I live in units 1511-1567 (Buildings 11 & 12)?

- Keep an eye out for a notification to arrive to your door this month;
- Read the notice carefully, reach out with questions, sign and return the receipt to IMS;

What should I do if I live in Buildings 1571-1795 (Buildings 1-10)?

- Keep an eye out for upcoming communication from IMS, TCB-CL and UCHC.
- Continue to enjoy the rest of your New Year!

January Tenant Council Meeting Recap!



United Community Housing Coalition (UCHC) hosted the CKG January Tenant Council meeting on January 29th in collaboration with Corktown Health, City of Detroit Health Department, and Wayne State University. The meeting started at 4:00pm with refreshments and food provided by UCHC. The event focused on health and vaccination awareness.

As residents signed in, they were given the option to wait in line for a Covid-19 vaccine and/or a Flu shot. While people got their shots, Mary Mackool, a nurse from Corktown Health spoke about the importance of getting a Covid-19 and Flu shot. Getting vaccinated means protecting yourself from getting sick, as well as your family and friends. Mary said people can get their Covid or Flu shots at any point of the year. You do not have to wait for the winter months. You can go to Corktown Health, located at 1726 Howard St, for walk-in vaccine service.

The next speaker was Sarah Lenhoff from Wayne State University. Sarah is doing a research study on neighborhood change, and she is looking to schedule interviews with residents of Clement Kern Gardens. She is interested in learning how residents think and feel about the upcoming changes to Corktown. The interviews happen once a year and last 60-90 minutes. ChargerHelp! (New Employment Opportunity) Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment Technician (EVSE) Training Program




