

Local Advisory Council (LAC)

The Detroit Department of Transportation (DDOT) Local Advisory Council (LAC) serves as the foundation for assessing, planning, and strengthening public transportation services in the community and to provide recommendations and input to local public transportation providers and other governing entities.

Membership

The LAC shall be composed of nine (9) Members, with at least one (1) Member being a resident of each of the seven (7) City Council Districts and two (2) at large Members, who shall represent the Detroit Area Agency of Aging. At least half of the LAC membership must be composed of Older Adults and Persons with Disabilities. The reminder of the LAC membership must represent social services organizations or governmental agencies that serves Older Adults and Persons with Disabilities.

Meetings

Meetings are held four (4) times a year on the 3rd Tuesday of the months of February, May, August, and November. A quorum of five members constitutes the majority. Members are appointed by the Director of DDOT.
