EMERGENCY PLANS

205.8 - 1 **PURPOSE**

Emergency plans are designed to assign tasks and responsibilities to individuals at specific sites during an emergency or disaster situation. These plans are required by federal and local regulations.

205.8 - 2 **POLICY**

The city of Detroit, Office of Emergency Management (OEM), has developed an Emergency Operations Plan (EOP) for the city of Detroit. This plan assigns broad-spectrum tasks to various departments within the city. Detroit Police Department precincts and facilities have Emergency Preparedness Plans (EPP's).

205.8 - 3 Site Emergency Plans

Site Emergency Plans include the following:

- a. Staging, rest, feeding assembly, and vehicle parking areas;
- b. Possible mass arrest detention sites;
- c. Barrier provisions for secured areas;
- d. Provisions for emergency signs, etc.;
- e. Security of precincts and plans for defense if necessary;
- f. Procedures for issuance of emergency equipment such as gas masks, rifles, shotguns, flak vests, etc.; and
- g. Location and capacity of facilities to be used for shelters in case of evacuation. Provide contact person and current telephone number.

201.1 - 3.1 Review and Testing

The commanding officer of each command shall cause the precinct or site Emergency Plan to be reviewed and updated annually. A copy of the revised approved plan shall be forwarded through channels to Downtown Services each year during the month of February.
