#### DDD TREE PROGRAM

Dead, Dangerous, and Diseased Tree program, which will allow residents to report trees on their private property they feel need to be trimmed or removed. If the trees qualify, they will be trimmed or removed, with no charge to the resident.

- the initial \$8.3M that was budgeted.

- as of today we have completed 452 tree requests
- residents who provided an email address with a monthly email that updates them on their waitlist number and also informs them that they are not guaranteed to receive service.

- You will receive notifications targeted to residents in a specific area experiencing emergency conditions.
- Your personal data is secure in the CodeRED system.






