

# 8 WEEK TRENDS as of 03/26/24

### **COVID-19 CASE RATE**

The 7-day average rate of new confirmed COVID-19 cases among City of Detroit residents is 24.6 daily cases per million people as of 03/11/2024. This has decreased compared to the previous report, when it was reported as 45.4 cases per million people.




Figure 1: COVID-19 confirmed (daily/1,000,000) cases

### **COVID-19 HOSPITAL ADMISSIONS**

The current COVID-19 hospital admissions level for Detroit, Wayne County is Low at 4.3 new COVID-19 hospital admissions per 100,000 population (7-day total).

### **COVID-19 INPATIENT BEDS**

There are currently 24 COVID-19 occupied inpatient beds and 9 COVID-19 occupied ICU beds recorded in the city of Detroit.




Figure 3: COVID-19 hospital occupancy

## **COVID-19 WASTEWATER MONITORING**

Wastewater monitoring shows 50% of sampling sites have detectable levels and 14% of sites have high levels of SARS-CoV-2 markers as of 03/18/2024 in the city of Detroit.

 The proportions are out of 22 sites across the city of Detroit from which wastewater samples are taken and tested for SARS-CoV-2 markers. Each sampling site represents a specific population based on the area its sewer shed covers, such as long-term care facilities, college dormitories, and entire ZIP code areas. Detectable levels are over 1000 copies/100mL; high levels are over 5000 copies/100mL.
