




# ROUTE OPTIONS

Option C & D eliminated in Meeting #1 and early survey results

No interest in one-way streets Safety/Engineering concerns with Springwells Viaduct at Chamberlain



## ROUTE OPTIONS

#### A. Vernor Highway


Pros: Address safety issues, improve existing bike lane, landscaping and maintenance

Cons: Remove parking on one side of the street, remove turn lanes

#### **B. Vernor Alley**

Pros: Adjacent to businesses, Lower volumes, fewer conflicts with vehicles, improving safety and maintenance of alley.

Cons: conflicts at intersection, shared with vehicles from businesses and adjacent homeowners, does not address Vernor Hwy safety issues

Business concerns about parking



### **Existing Conditions**

Pavement quality varies
Intermittent lighting
No crosswalks



### **Shared Space**

Low-speed, low-volume shared space
Repave for smooth, accessible surface
Improve lighting
Add crossings at streets


# ALLEY CROSSINGS

### **Creating safe crossings**


- Raised crossings

- Increase visibility for greenway users







# RAILROAD VIADUCTS


Springwells safety issues


